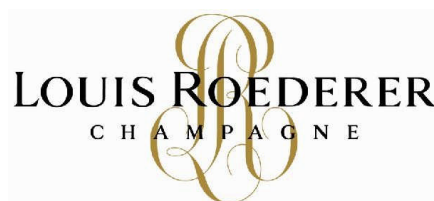

- 11 Le Petit Ange Blanc, France 2005** 11.95  
*The Little Angel aptly describes the honesty, unpretentious, beauty and charm of this wine. Crafted from 100% Grenache Blanc with notes of apple and exotic fruits shine through with an elegance and refinement, which makes it a privilege to drink on its own or to complement any fish and white meat dishes.*
- 12 Paloma de la Paz, Sauvignon Blanc, Chile 2006** 13.95  
*We picked our Sauvignon Blanc by hand and then cool fermented it in order to enhance the gooseberry, citrus aromas and freshness. The citric character and soft tropical notes on the palate make this a perfect complement to seafood or why not drink as an aperitif.*
- 13 La Casada , Pinot Grigio, Italy 2006** 15.95  
*What can we say, great Pinot Grigio – fresh and crisp with an appley melon twist. Everything you would expect in a Pinot Grigio and a lot more! Wonderful cream soda nose, crisp lively acidity backed by classic flavours of melon, peach kernels and a slightly spicy finish.*

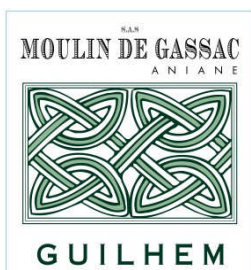
- 14 Rosé Syrah, Cuvee Valonnee, Vin de Pays D'oc, Southern France 2005** 12.95  
*A brilliant pink colour, with a soft red fruit fragrance on the nose, backed up by a gentle but evident structure on the palate.*

## Red

- 15 Le Petit Ange Rouge, Southern France 2006** 11.95  
*Crafted from 100% Carignan - spicy, exotic and peppery notes are elegantly balanced by the smooth, soft, refined texture making this wine a privilege to drink on its own or to complement red meats, pasta and dishes with rich sauces.*
- 16 Paloma de la Paz, Cabernet Sauvignon, Chile 2005** 13.95  
*Our Cabernet comes from old vines planted in alluvial soils in the central Valley of Chile, hand pick to ensure the highest quality This shows lovely dark red fruits, bramble, cassis and some spice backed by soft, easy tannins and a powerful finish. Drink with red meats or on its own.*
- 17 Merlot, Red Earth, Australia 2003** 15.95  
*Vibrant rich crimson with strawberry, mulberry and blackberry fruit with a touch of spicy oak. A powerful red, ideal with red meats and game.*

19	<b>Cuvée Valonnée, Sauvignon Blanc, Vin de Pays D'oc 2003</b> <i>This wine exhibits the most fantastic rich varietal flavours: pronounced aromas of green apples followed by rich, dry greengage/grapefruit characteristics with a long elegant finish. The richness and crisp acidity make this a perfect aperitif wine, complementing all fish and white meat dishes.</i>	13.95
20	<b>Guilhem Blanc, Moulin de Gassac (Organic) 2005</b> <i>This wine is made by arguably the best winemaker in the South of France – it is wonderfully fresh and clean with aromas and flavours of apples and gooseberries.</i>	14.95

The elegance and high concentration of fruit and tannin make it a perfect partner to a wide variety of dishes including both red and white meat and even as an aperitif. A beautifully crafted wine.</i>	13.95
23	<b>Montagne Noir, Merlot 2005</b> <i>Deep in colour with intense, welcoming fruit flavours and a hint of spice on the palate; immensely drinkable and versatile.</i>	14.95
24	<b>Guilhem Rouge, Moulin de Gassac (Organic) Vin de P, l'Herault 2005</b> <i>Bright ruby red colour with a complex nose and ripe red berry aromas. Soft, fruity and structured on the palate and good tannins too. This is a suave and lightly rustic wine of great length. A perfect wine for everyday – delightful too with light and elegant meals such as shell fish and grilled meats.</i>	14.95

- 26 **Château du Cros, Sauvignon Blanc 2005** 15.95  
*Classic Bordeaux Sauvignon not too pungent nor too weak. Rich gooseberries and elderflower flavour with green crisp acidity on the finish.*

## **Claret**

- 27 **Château Lagrange les Tours, Bordeaux Superieur 2002** 15.95  
*This wine has a lovely deep purple colour, offers ripe bramble, spice and cedar on the nose and a super soft, black-fruited, balanced finish.*
- 28 **Château du Cros, Bordeaux Rouge 2002** 16.95  
*Deep purple/garnet colour, restrained nose, soft elegant palate; blackcurrants, touch of spice, medium bodied.*
- 29 **Château la Fleur Chantecaille, St Emilion 2000** 21.95  
*A well-structured wine with beautiful ruby colour, a delicate fruity nose and harmonious palate, with dense and fine tannins and also good length.*
- 30 **Château le Boscq, Cru Bourgeois, Medoc 2001** 23.95  
*A well regarded Chateau of this appellation, Cabernet dominated, it is typically medium to full bodied with hints of blackcurrant and cedar on the nose.*
- 31 **Frank Phélan (2nd Wine), Château Phélan Ségur, St Estephe 2001** 39.95  
*Rich and soft with well balanced tannins. Surprisingly open with a good powerful finish.*
- 32 **La Roseraie de Gruaud Larose (2<sup>nd</sup> Wine) St Julien 2000** 49.95  
*As the second wine of the great Château Gruaud Larose, Roseraie de Gruaud Larose stands out as one of the best of the second wines of Bordeaux.*

## **Burgundy – White**

- 33 **Maçon Villages, Joseph Drouhin 2006** 19.95  
*Pale straw golden colour, exhibiting classic white Burgundy aromas, butter and bread, with rich chardonnay fruit on the palate.*
- 34 **Bourgogne Blanc, Olivier Leflaive 2005** 23.95  
*The classification of this wine belies its noble origins. Grown in the villages of Puligny-Montrachet and Meursault from the flatter south: southeast-facing slopes, just outside of each commune. 80% barrel fermented, 20% stainless steel.*
- 35 **Petit Chablis, Louis Michel et Fils, 2005** 26.95  
*Ripe aromas of lemon, stone fruits and a touch of fruit. This is a sweet and supple wine which offers good freshness and complexity with a long finish.*
- 36 **Montagny 1er Cru, Olivier Leflaive 2005** 29.95  
*From Premier Cru vineyards of relatively high marl soil content, giving a slightly more citric grapefruit quality to the wine. Weighty but with mineral touches and gently infused vanilla oak.*
- 37 **Château de Fuisse, Pouilly-Fuissé 2000** 32.95  
*Golden to the eye, it has an intense bouquet of dried fruit with nuances of vanilla and oak. On the palate it is fleshy, generous and full flavoured giving flavours of white peaches on the finish*
- 38 **Chablis 1er Cru Vaillons, Louis Michel et Fils 2003** 36.95  
*Wonderful abundance of fruit, soft, rich and powerful with the tell tale minerally overtone. Elegant and refined.*
- 39 **Adamas, Meursault 2004** 44.95  
*Adamas Meursault has richness and complexity. It should be served slightly chilled and it is delicious at any time of the day or night, with or without food, but must be shared with good friends. Classic white Burgundy. Beautifully balanced fruit flavours and subtle toasty oak with a long lasting finish.*

- Burgundy - Red**
- 40 **Laforêt Bourgogne Rouge, Joseph Drouhin 2005** 19.95  
*Light red with a nice fruity Pinot Noir scent. Lively fruit flavours and spicy tones with a good finish. A pleasant style to suit meat and game.*
- 41 **Chorey les Beaune, Joseph Drouhin 2004** 29.95  
*Dark red with a powerful nose. Good structure, rich, elegant and well balanced with a very fine finish picking up flavours of liquorice.*
- 42 **Adamas, Volnay 2003** 42.95  
*Adamas Volnay is the essence of feminine charm and although it can be enjoyed now, it will benefit from a short period of ageing. Excellent for candle-lit dinners with very close friends.*
- 43 **Adamas, Nuits Saint Georges 2004** 49.95  
*Adamas Nuits Saint Georges has the finesse of Pinot Noir together with the masculine structure typical of this great Burgundy village.*
- Beaujolais - Red**
- 44 **Joseph Drouhin, Beaujolais-Villages 2005** 17.95  
*It has a bright purple colour, a very intense nose, reminiscent of violets, peonies and red berries. On the palate, it has a silky smoothness, and its delicious fruit lingers for a long time. Beaujolais Villages is very versatile with all kinds of food.*
- 45 **Fleurie, George Boulon 2005** 26.95  
*The most popular of the 10 Beaujolais "Crus. George Boulon is the mayor of Chiroubles and his Fontabon estate straddles the Fleurie border. Classic, Silky Gamay fruit and now showing some maturity.*
- Rhone - White**
- 46 **Côtes du Rhône Blanc, J. Vidal-Fleury 2005** 19.95  
*100% Viognier. A delightfully pretty rounded floral nose with some alcohol evident. The palate is soft and rich with good varietal character. Very good.*
- Rhone - Red**
- 47 **Le Pigeolet Rouge, Vin de Pays de Vaucluse, Vignobles Brunier 2004** 19.95  
*This is absolutely delicious: soft and juicy with gorgeous plum-like fruit backed by Rhône spice.*
- 48 **Cote du Rhone Parallele 45, Paul Jaboulet 2005** 19.95  
*One of the outstanding wines of the appellation. Deep ruby/garnet in colour with a nose of baked red fruits. Full bodied – a really delicious mouthful of wine.*
- 49 **Paul Jaboulet, Crozes Hermitage, Les Jalets 2004** 25.95  
*This wine has wonderful damson colour, which exhibits both from the palate and the nose flavours reminiscent of black pepper, spice and sweet cherries. Rich and full.*
- 50 **Chateauneuf du Pape, Clos la Rouquet Rouge 2001** 39.95  
*Expressive garrigue herb, red fruit, clove and chocolate aromas. These characters combine with fine ripe tannins and a touch of dry spice due to a higher percentage of Syrah.*
- Alsace - White**
- 51 **Fleur d'Alsace, Hugel et Fils 2005** 18.95  
*A fantastic wine, dry and fresh with wonderful floral aromas and flavours. Made from the four aristocratic grapes of Alsace, this classic wine allies the suave spicy flavour of Gewurztraminer, the body of Pinot Gris, the finesse of Riesling and the grapiness of Muscat.*
- 52 **Gewürztraminer Hugel & Fils 2004** 24.95  
*Intense perfumed nose of rose petals and lychees, with an oily texture. Everything you would expect. A wonderfully powerful wine.*

## Loire - White

- 53 **Muscadet de Sevre et Maine, Domaine de la Foliette, Sur Lie, Vieilles Vignes 2005** 13.95  
*In the right hands, as this Muscadet is, it has great charm and character - very clean and fresh with a slight 'petillance' - versatile, can accompany any fish or white meats.*
- 54 **Pouilly Fumé, Patrice Moreux 2006** 21.95  
*Wonderful concentration of fresh gooseberry and cut grass aromas with classic smokey, apple tart nose, nice full palate with good balance. A super food wine. Fresh Sauvignon, slightly smoky, nice apple, citric, gooseberry fruit with lovely fresh, dry clean finish.*
- 55 **Sancerre Blanc, Domaine Hubert, Brochard 2006** 24.95  
*Light/medium in body, it offers an aromatic nose of grapefruit, lime, spice and mineral notes. Dry unoaked, it offers fresh flavours of citrus, minerals and herbs. The wine has beautifully balanced fruit and acidity. It is smooth and clean with a lingering finish.*

## Red

- 56 **Sancerre Rouge, Domaine Hubert, Brochard 2003** 28.95  
*100% Pinot Noir – try slightly chilled with poultry dishes.*

## *Italy*

### White

- 57 **Il Paradosso, Chardonnay / Inzolia, 2005** 12.95  
*Fresh stone fruits on the nose, followed by a zingy citrus fruit character with a hint of creaminess on the palate.*
- 58 **Soave Classico Superiore, Inama 2003** 24.95  
*10% barrel and 90% stainless steel fermented with some new oak ageing. This is surprisingly fresh and full-flavoured, showing elderflower scents with super length and balance on the finish.*

### Red

- 59 **Il Paradosso, Nero d'avola / Shiraz 2005** 12.95  
*Spicy red fruits dominate the nose, with a good structure of dark berried character filling the palate.*
- 60 **Montepulciano d'Abruzzo, La Botte 2005** 13.95  
*Big muscular Montepulciano with red and black savoury fruits and a solid core of ripe fruits.*
- 61 **Castello di Bossi, Chianti Classico 2003** 29.95  
*This wine is superbly ripe and rich with blackberries and slightly toasted oak. The palate is full bodied with a solid core of fruit and a medium finish.*

## *Spain*

### Red

- 62 **Rioja Crianza, Heredad de Altillo 2003** 17.95  
*A medium bodied wine with a soft, red berry character backed up with a structure that makes it an ideal partner for meat based dishes.*
- 63 **Bodegas Campillo, Rioja Reserva 1999** 32.95  
*Deep, complex aromas with very developed hint of fruit, leather and vanilla. On the palate, it is powerful and full-bodied with a well-balanced tannic flavour on the finish.*

## Germany

- 64 **Von-Othegraven, Riesling Qba Trocken Saar 2003** 26.95  
*Well made Riesling with limey fruit character on the nose and a very clean off-dry palate, the slight sweetness being balanced by lively, fresh acidity. Slightly fuller than many German lines, it is ideal as an aperitif or as a partner to smoked salmon or ham dishes.*

## Australia

### White

- 65 **Jacobite Ridge, Chardonnay, Australia 2006** 15.95  
*Fruity and robust, the Jacobite Ridge Chardonnay is a full-bodied wine with powerful, soft tropical flavours backed with melons, figs and a creaminess enhanced by the subtle presence of oak.*
- 66 **Sauvignon Blanc, Ceravolo Estate, Adelaide Hills 2004** 18.95  
*Bottled young to capture its vibrant fresh style - leafy and herbaceous aromas with a zesty palate of limes, lychees and green apples made for immediate enjoyment to enhance all manner of lightly spiced foods, seafoods and salads or ideal as an aperitif.*
- 67 **Tilly's Vineyard, Barossa Dry White, Henschke 2004** 22.95  
*The outstanding and beautifully-fruited 2004 (a selection of Semillon, Chardonnay and Sauvignon Blanc), exhibits honeyed citrus, tropical fruit and crushed stone characteristics in a medium-bodied, layered elegant format. This primarily tank-fermented and aged white reveals a touch of oak in its aromas and flavours.*
- 68 **Julius Riesling, Eden Valley, Henschke 2004** 28.95  
*Delicate fragrant citrus blossom, lime juice and zesty with good intensity and persistence backed up by good concentration with a crisp acidity and a long finish.*

### Red

- 69 **Jacobite Ridge, Shiraz, Australia 2005** 15.95  
*Rich and velvety with classic blackcurrant spiciness and that tell tale vanilla/oak characteristic blending in beautifully – a really lovely wine.*
- 70 **Sangiovese, Ceravolo Estate, Adelaide Plains 2004** 18.95  
*Aromas of violets, cherries & raspberry with soft velvety, aromatic and spicy characters after ageing for 12 months in French and American oak.*
- 71 **Shiraz, Ceravolo Estate, Adelaide Plains 2002 (Award Winning)** 24.95  
*Ripe mulberries, blackberry, black cherry, strawberry, blueberry with a hint of chocolate and oriental spice.*
- 72 **Keyneton Estate, Euphonium Barossa, Henschke 2002** 39.95  
*Delivers an imposingly deep glow in the glass. The nose beckons with a wealth of ripe berry fruit, smoke and spice. The flavour is profound - damson, cherry and currant fill the mouth. It has the texture of crushed velvet. A blend of Shiraz, Cabernet Sauvignon and Merlot.*

## New Zealand

### White

- 73 **Francesca Bay, Sauvignon Blanc 2005** 21.95  
*Wonderful concentration of fresh crisp fruit. Lush, fat and plump, this wine is also precise and pure ...it bastes the palate with its copious fruit... superb.*
- 74 **Mount Vernon, Unoaked Chardonnay, Lawson's Dry Hills 2005** 23.95  
*Mount Vernon's has an engaging flavour of white peaches, creaminess and a crisp, refreshing finish. A highly satisfying wine, which will never tire the palate.*

- Red**
- 75 **Pinot Noir, Francesca Bay 2005** 27.95  
*This classic New Zealand Pinot Noir is grown on selected Marlborough vineyards and is carefully and selectively harvested by hand. Aged in oak casks, this fine wine has a vibrant colour and a complex abundance of strawberry, cherry and dark berry fruit.*

## California

- 76 **Russian River, Chardonnay Solex 2003** 36.95  
*Solex is a 100% Chardonnay wine made from grapes grown in Sonoma County. Eighty-five percent of these grapes are from the Russian River and the rest are from the Sonoma Coast. A clean, crisp Chardonnay with full flavours of apricot, banana and spicy oak.*

- Red**
- 77 **Zinnia Zinfandel, Russian River 2001** 22.50  
*A jammy, fruit-forward style of Zinfandel. Easily approachable wine that marries a hint of spice with strawberries, plum and soft, round tannins. Nicely toasted oak lingers on the finish.*

## South Africa

- White**
- 78 **Chenin Blanc, The Veldt Range 2006** 13.95  
*A really well balanced wine: the aromas are reminiscent of melon and honey with soft tropical fruit flavours dominating the palate and an elegant, refreshing acidity on the finish.*

- 79 **Medium Gewurtztraminer, The Veldt Range 2005** 15.95  
*Full bodied wine with aromas of honey suckle and rose petals. Rich and smooth, beautifully balanced sugar and acid. An uncomplicated wine ideal with fresh fruit based desserts and mild soft cheese or as an aperitif.*

- Red**
- 80 **Pinotage, The Veldt Range 2005** 15.95  
*Packed with ripe, jammy fruits of the forest flavours. Soft, mellow and velvety smooth – refreshing and medium bodied.*

## Chile & Argentina

- White**
- 81 **La Rareza, Torrontes, Argentina 2005** 13.95  
*Floral, fresh and aromatic on the nose leading on to a soft, fruity palate making this an easy drinking but quite delicious wine.*

- 82 **Santa Ema, Chardonnay, Chile 2005** 15.95  
*A perfect balance of tropical fruits make this a fresh, full wine with a long, pleasant finish. An elegant, complex wine with light notes of toast and vanilla.*

- Red**
- 83 **La Rareza, Malbec, Argentina 2005** 13.95  
*Evocative red tones with hints of cherry and plum. Mature fruit notes in the mouth. Elegant body and delicate touches of vanilla. Perfect to accompany ham, pasta and strong cheese.*

- 84 **Santa Ema, Merlot Reserve, Chile 2004** 19.95  
*Mature blackberry and blueberry flavours together with sweet, toasty notes. A perfect union of fruit and wood, it is an elegant and structured wine with a good finish. A remarkable wine.*
